The application for aboveground flammable/combustible storage and dispensing tanks is reviewed on a case by case basis.

- 1. The maximum Class I liquid permitted per assessor parcel shall be in accordance with the California Fire Code.
- 2. Aboveground storage in tanks of Class I and II liquids is prohibited in residential zones. Tanks may be installed in industrial and commercial zones in accordance with the California Fire Code.
- 3. Provide the following for review and consideration by the Fire Marshal's Office.
