

# EMERGENCY INFORMATION CARDS

Every family member should carry an emergency information card in addition to personal identification. We have provided three cards here. If you have more family members, you may wish to fill in the information and then make as many copies as you'll need.

Fill in the blanks with your family's emergency information, cut the cards apart and fold them in half on the solid line to fit into a wallet.

An out-of-state contact is someone designated to be called if family members are apart and unable to call each other due to congested local telephone circuits. Make sure that the out-of-state contact understands his or her role to keep track of your family members in the event of a local emergency.

In case of an emergency that occurs when all family members are not at home, designate a place nearby where everyone can meet. For an evacuation of an area greater than your street or neighborhood, designate an out-of-area place to meet.
